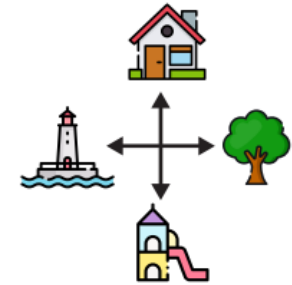
Reasoning
